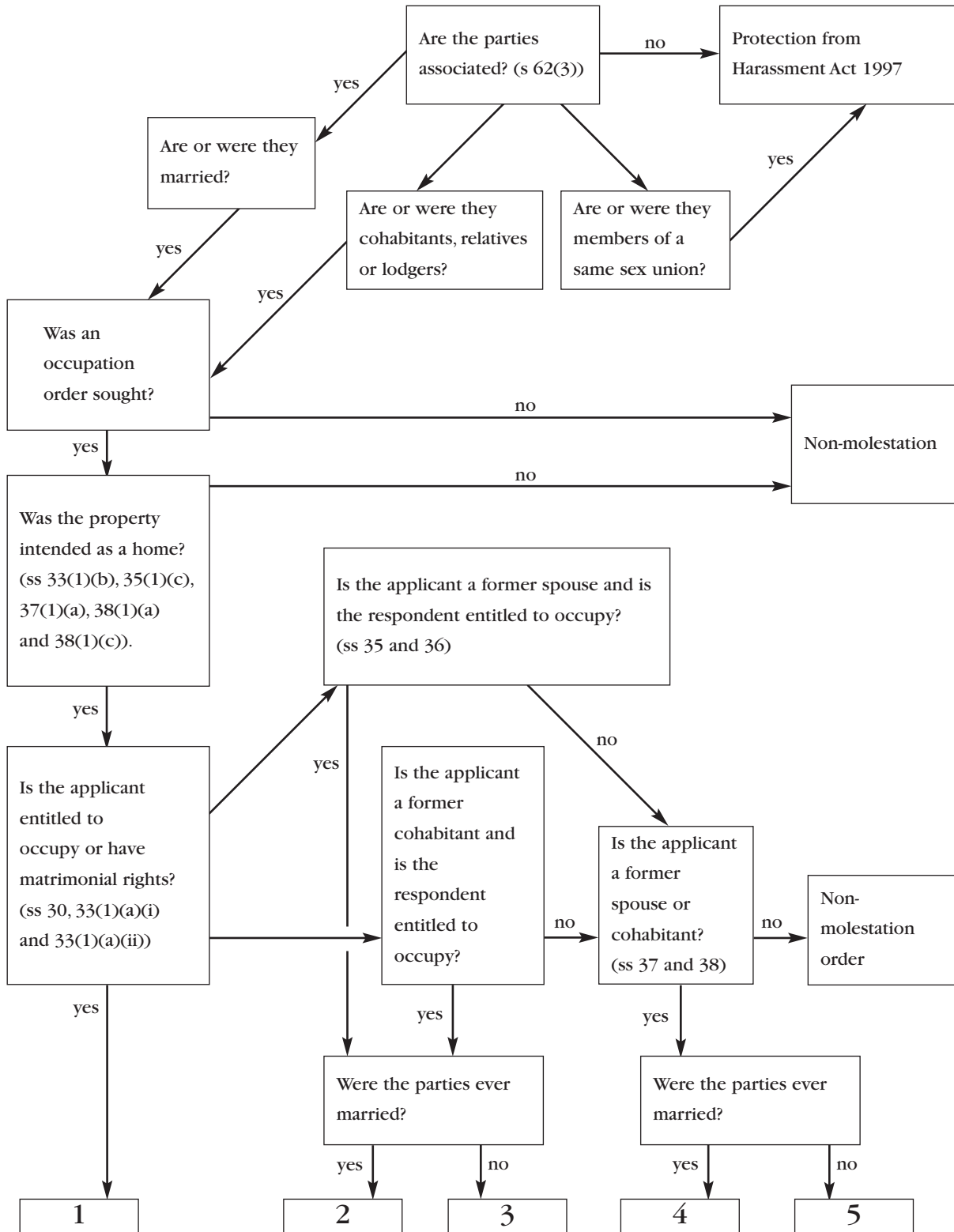

2	<p>Balance of harm test and period since cessation (s 35(6), (7), (8))</p> <p>Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) occupation order rights plus; (2) regulating occupation; (3) varying respondent's right to occupy; (4) requiring respondent to leave; (5) excluding respondent from area; <p>(s 35(3), (4), 36(3), (4), (5))</p> <p>Result - 6 months with extensions of up to 6 months (s 35(10))</p>
3	<p>Significant harm test and nature of relationship (s 36(6), (7), (8))</p> <p>Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) occupation rights order plus; (2) regulation of occupation; (3) varying respondent's right to occupy; (4) requiring respondent to leave; (5) excluding respondent from area; <p>(s 35(3), (4), (5), 36(3), (4), (5))</p> <p>Result - 6 months with civil extension of up to 6 months (s 36(10))</p>
4	<p>Balance of harm test (ss 33(6), (7), 37(4))</p> <p>Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) occupation rights order; (2) permitting applicant to return; (3) regulating occupation; (4) requiring respondent to leave; (5) excluding respondent from area; <p>(ss 37(3), 38(3))</p> <p>Result - 6 months with extensions of up to 6 months (s 37(5))</p>
5	<p>Significant harm test (s 38(4), (5))</p> <p>Options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) occupation rights order; (2) permitting applicant to return; (3) regulating occupation; (4) requiring respondent to leave; (5) excluding respondent from area; <p>(ss 37(3), 38(3))</p> <p>Result - 6 months with one extension of up to 6 months (s 38(6))</p>
